- the ability and willingness to travel both in the UK and overseas as required; and
- the ability to work effectively as part of a wider multi-disciplinary team.

Successful applicants will join us each autumn and will be trained in an initial structured 24 month programme, on the job, by recognised leaders from within our industry. You will learn about the different aspects of capital project development and be encouraged to gain chartered status with the relevant engineering institutions as part of our accredited schemes. You will also be trained and become familiar with some of Fichtner's in-house modelling tools and develop skills in external modelling tools. You will liaise directly with our clients, contractors, operators and suppliers as necessary.
